



Images/footage Consent Information form

Bendigo Autistic Advocacy and Support Service (BAASS) recognises the need to ensure the welfare and safety of all young people taking part in any activity associated with our organisation.

In accordance with our child protection policy we will not permit photographs, video or other images of young people to be taken without the consent of the parents/carers and children.

BAASS asks that all participants and their associates commit to our Child Protection Policy guidelines and do not take photographs or video footage of any person other than your own child/ren whilst engaging in BAASS programs and events. The BAASS Child Protection Policy is available on request and on our website.

This applies to all visitors and associates of BAASS.

As your child will be taking part in a BAASS program or event, we would like to ask for your consent to take photographs/videos during sessions that may contain images of your child. It is likely that these images may be used as:

- a record of the activity or the event
- publicity material for further activities or events on leaflets/websites/magazines
- illustrations of the activities or events in published articles (eg. Newspaper, TV)
- future grant applications

BAASS will take all steps to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes they are intended. If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately you should inform BAASS immediately.
